 - a. Handbook – *Steven Rosen*
 - i. The chapter was recently reviewed by a few volunteers.
 - ii. The committee at large is asked to review the chapter.
 - iii. There is a new handbook liaison.
 - iv. The Online version of the handbook and the Online Plus version will be combined.
 - b. Research – *John Kennedy*
 - i. Art Geisler is still the Section 1 research liaison
 1. There is a “Drought” of RTAR’s- encouraging submissions.
 2. Research is spending \$2.7 mil this year.

 - 2. Bourassa- with TC 4.2- move ASHRAE content to electronic delivery method.
 - 3. Galler- hardware security- SCADA systems.
 - 4. Kennedy and Branson- Develop list of possible RTAR topics based on 1468.
 - iii. Welle- Writing a RTAR to create data model to integrate data models – concept and write-up will be refined.
 - iv. Research training:
 - 19 awarded, 28 completed
 - 62 active, 11 closing soon
 - 5 proposals were reviewed in the spring, all were rejected.
